In an effort to align with our KFCS's mission statement of "100% graduation is our expectation" we are changing the length of 7<sup>th</sup> period starting January 30, 2017. Seventh period will now continue until 3:30 p.m. starting 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. Please make a note of this and plan your day accordingly.

We are making this change to enable our students to be successful in school. This last semester we invited students to take advantage of this time built into our schedule from 3:05-3:30 p.m. to make up tests, redo assignments and turn in missing work. This approach has produced limited success. Therefore, we will be requiring students who need this extra time to use these additional minutes of 7<sup>th</sup> period to stay on track for graduation.

Students who have demonstrated success in their classes first semester will be dismissed early at 3:05 for these days. Students who are failing one or more classes at first semester will be required to stay in their 7<sup>th</sup> period class until the end of the school day at 3:30 p.m.
